

PRIVACY POLICY

What we collect :

We may collect the following information:

Timely Processing :

We will not keep personal data longer than is necessary for the purpose or purposes for which it was collected. We will take all reasonable steps to destroy, or erase from our systems, all data which is no longer required.

Security :

Legal basis for processing your data :

We will process your data under one or more of the following legal bases:

Legitimate interests – At times we may feel that it is in your legitimate interest that we contact you. We will participate in business-to-business communication. We believe our correspondence would be in line with your reasonable expectations and would not have an unwarranted impact on you. However you will always have the right to object or opt out.
